

Tower Ranch opens

About a year after the groundbreaking, Kelowna's first golf course community opened it's doors.

The Tower Ranch, located at the end of the newly-expanded McCurdy Road, is the first of its kind in Kelowna and everyone is welcome to come take a look.

General manager, Gord Sarkissian, says the community is the result of a partnership between several companies.

"We have some of the best minds in their fields working together on this community. IntraWest, a leader in building planned communities, Aberdeen Golf Group and golf course architect Thomas McBroom, have all come together to bring about the vision of Okanagan resident, Stan Tower," says Sarkissian.

The opening of the Towers was tied into the opening of the expansion of McCurdy Road, which now leads directly up to the new golf community.

"I'm glad we were able to work with the City of Kelowna on the road expansion, it benefits all of us."

Head golf professional, Neil Schmidt, says nine of the 18 holes are finished.

"We are just waiting for the seed to take on the final holes, so they should all be ready by next spring, when we hope to have our first full round of golf! Until then, everyone is invited to come up for a tour of the greens and show homes," says Schmidt.

The third phase of homes is now on sale.
